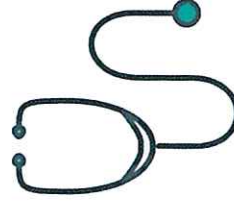
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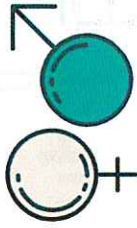

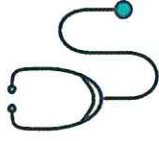


Introduction to Reproductive Health

This introductory half-day or full-day workshop covers the fundamentals of reproductive health, contraceptives, STIs and how to discuss these topics with clients. The topics below are available as stand-alone sessions. This is a great training for community health workers, medical assistants, health educators, case managers, home visitors, and promotoras.
