- ☑ Enrollment into the Empowered Young Parents Program(EYPP).
  - EYPP services are designed to support young mothers, fathers, and their children.
  - We assist in gaining tools for self-sufficiency, encourage advocacy and aid the development of strong parenting skills. AzCA specializes in the various needs and opportunities for young parents who have experienced foster care or the juvenile court system.
- ☑ Referrals and resources:
  - Assistance with establishing health insurance.
  - Access to high schools, colleges, GED and job training programs.
  - Assistance with finding safe and appropriate childcare.
- ☑ Navigation services:
  - One-on-one assistance working towards parenting success in the areas of: counseling, housing, employment, education and personal finances.
  - As needed funding may be available to help maintain parenting success and stability.
  - One-on-one parenting skills and training.
